Gotsport Online Check In Process

Items listed below need to be uploaded via gotsport in your team account, using the documents tab, by Friday, May 19th, 5pm.

- Team Official Roster, PDF VERSION ONLY
Must be from Fall 2022, or Spring of 2023 League season.
- Tournament Roster/KISS Liability Release Form, PDF VERSION ONLY
- ***IF APPLICABLE***Club Passcarding Players, official team roster. This only applies to players that are passcarding within the club., PDF VERSION ONLY
- ***IF APPLICABLE***Copy of permission to travel form (Applicable to out of state teams only, [Indiana Site](#), [Ohio Site](#)) PDF VERSION ONLY
- ***IF APPLICABLE***Guest Player Forms (Michigan teams can get guest player forms [here](#), out of state teams can get them from their state association) PDF VERSION ONLY

Items listed below must be with the manager or coach during the tournament at all times:

- [Medical Release Forms](#) (out of state teams may have different form)
- [Concussion Parent Athlete Form](#)
- Player and Coach Passcards for all players participating**
NOTE: All player passcards will be verified at the first game of the tournament for each team.
- Risk Management cards for all team officials
- Safesport Certifications for all team officials that will be on the sideline

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can we register on site Saturday morning?

NO, all registration must be done via the online registration method or via mail. There are no exceptions!

Can players play for more than 1 team?

NO, This is a state sanctioned event and must follow statewide tournament rules. Players can not sub for other teams as well.
